NOTICE

How to Indicate Office/Issue Choice Official Federal Write-In Absentee Ballot

In a primary election you may only vote for candidates from one party.

President:

• **Democratic:**

○ Delegates-at-Large: State Delegate-at-Large, print the name of the candidate

and the candidate's party affiliation

• **Republican:** (2 offices available)

○ Delegates-at-Large: State Delegate-at-Large, print the name of the candidate and the candidate's party affiliation

○ District Delegates: State District Delegate (4th District), print the name of the candidate and the candidate's party affiliation

U. S. Senator: Print the name of the candidate and the candidate's party affiliation

U. S. Representative: Print the name of the candidate and the candidate's party affiliation

All other offices / Initiatives:

- Under the Office / Ballot Initiative Section:
 - Specifically list the Office Title or Issue Number/Political Subdivision.
If the office has a term date you must include the term (Full Term Commencing or Unexpired Term Ending along with the date)

Examples:

- Judge of the Court of Appeals 3rd District Full Term Commencing 1-2-13
 - State Representative 45th District
 - Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) Delphos City School District
- Under the Candidate Name, Party Affiliation, or Initiative Vote Section:
 - Candidate: print the name of the candidate and the candidate's party affiliation
 - Initiative: Print the proper response

Examples:

- Yes
- No
- For the Tax Levy
- Against the Tax Levy
